

Social Distancing and COVID-19 Safety

Firstly, we hope that you have all been keeping safe and well during the lockdown – over the past few months, life has been turned upside down for all of us in ways we never expected. Here at Lower Barns, we have been working very hard behind the scenes to put the right safety measures in place that mean we can welcome you back to Cornwall as soon as the Government allows us to do so.

Nook and Cranny are separate self-contained apartments with their own walled gardens. The Hideaway and the B&B room are set away from the house and has its own private garden. The Hayloft family apartment has its own private entrance. Lower Barn is set within 2 acres, so there is plenty of space to roam. Our ethos is about giving couples and families time to spend together which is so important, now more than ever.

We have completed a thorough COVID-19 Risk Assessment which is published on our website. Our priority at this time is the safety of guests and our team, which means that while some elements of your stay with us will have to change slightly, we know that we can still offer you the Lower barn experience you know and love. The additional hygiene and social distancing measures well be introducing are outlined below.

Opening Date

- We are awaiting confirmation from the Government but we will be ready to open our doors to guests on the 3rd of December 2020.

Cleaning Procedures

- We will be increasing the level of cleaning in the rooms and apartments and communal areas with anti-viral products.
- We will be keeping in line with the COVID-19 Cleaning Guidance issued by the Professional Association of Self Caterers (PASC).
- The additional housekeeping may require some adjustment of arrival and departure times which we will confirm with booked guests nearer the time.
- Hand sanitiser will now be situated around the Lower Barn but we would appreciate you bringing your own small bottle of hand sanitiser, to carry at all times.

Facilities and Activities on Site

- Hot tub availability currently under review. To be confirmed.

Communal Areas and Equipment

- We will be asking guests to adopt the rules of social distancing, keeping 2 metres away from everyone outside their household.
- We will be asking guests to wash their hands after touching any communal services such as gates, door handles etc.

- We will be asking guests to bring their own gloves, face mask and hand sanitiser.

Food

The lovely team from Angels in the Kitchen will still be happy to pre-deliver homemade food to your freezer if you are staying in Nook or Cranny. We also offer in-house cooking from £40 per head, children £15 per head – we only ask that orders are made before your arrival.
