Social Distancing and COVID-19 Safety

Firstly, we hope that you have all been keeping safe and well. Here at Lower Barns, we have been working very hard behind the scenes to put the right safety measures in place in order to welcome you back to Cornwall.

Here is some information about what we've doing to make that possible:

Our accommodation

- 1. Nook and Cranny are separate self-contained apartments with their own walled gardens. We serve breakfast to your rooms.
- 2. The Hideaway B&B room is set away from the house and has its own private garden with Gypsy Caravan where we serve you breakfast.
- 3. The Hayloft family apartment has its own private entrance. Lawn-side and Garden suite use the same main entrance to Lower Barn. We serve Breakfast to these 3 rooms within main house with individual spaced tables for your breakfast.

Safety Measures:

- Hand sanitiser is situated around Lower Barn, but we would appreciate you bringing your own small bottle of hand sanitiser, to carry at all times.
- We will be asking guests to wash their hands after touching any communal services such as gates, door handles etc.
- We will be asking guests to adopt the rules of social distancing, keeping 2 metres away from everyone outside their household.
- We will not be cleaning your rooms while you are staying at Lower barns but Housekeeping are more than happy to change towels etc.
- We will be increasing the level of cleaning in all communal areas with anti-viral products daily.
- We will be keeping in line with the COVID-19 Cleaning Guidance issued by the Professional Association of Self Caterers (PASC).
- We will be increasing the level of cleaning in the rooms and apartments and communal areas with anti-viral products on departure of all guest.
- There will be glove, sanitiser available but we ask guests to bring their own gloves, face mask and hand sanitiser as well.
- The additional housekeeping may require some adjustment of arrival and departure times which we will confirm with booked guests nearer the time.

Lower Barn is set within 2 acres, so there is plenty of space to roam. Our ethos is about giving couples and families time to spend together which is so important, now more than ever.

Our priority at this time is the safety of guests and our team, which means that while some elements of your stay with us will have to change slightly, we know that we can still offer you the Lower barn experience you know and love.
